Pets

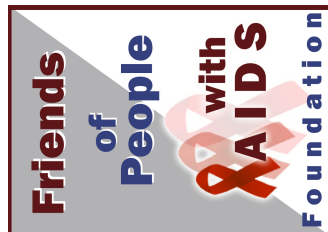

Cremation

When people are facing the end of their lives, the last thing they or their families need to be worried about is what will happen with them afterwards. We pay for cremations, allowing people with AIDS to face their final journey with dignity.

With the help of numerous community partners and volunteers, we host a Holiday Party in December for families with children living with their own or their parent's HIV/AIDS. 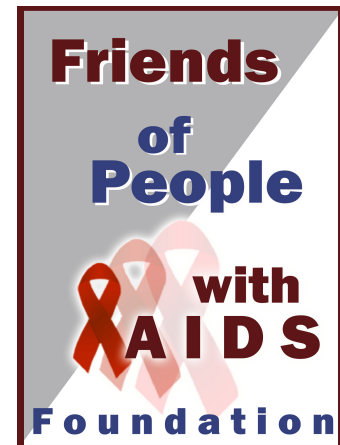

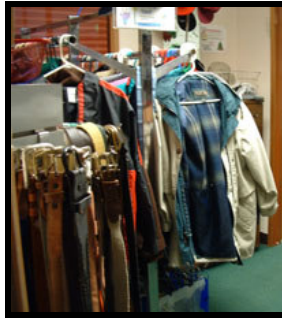
We work with other agencies in the community to enhance the quality of life for people living with HIV/AIDS.
